

March Anno Domini 1799.

These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freemen, & Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town Affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town, on Monday the 4th Day of March Next, at 12 o'clock, at Noon, on said Day, then & there, —

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r,

Affixors, Constables, & all other Town Officers, Required by Law, to be annually chosen, in the Month of March, or April, —

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways, by a Rate the present year, & grant a suitable sum of Money, for Repairing the same, —

3^d To see, if the Town will give Liberty, for Swine to go at Large, the present year, —

4th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Horses to go at Large, without fetters, any part of the present year, from the first day of April, to the Last Day of September, —

5th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Sheep, to go at Large, from the 15th Day of March, to the 1st Day of May Next, —

6th To see, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the Selectmen with the Town Treas^r, & order the same to be Recorded, —

7th To see, if the Town, will make an additional grant, to the Rev^d Mr. Biglow, Stated Salary, the present year, or Do or act, any other way, on this Article, as the Town shall think best when Met, —

8th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for Repairing the School-House, in the South East District in said Town, — Do. or act &c &c —

9th To see, if the Town will appoint an Agent, or agents to appear in Behalf of said Town, at the Court of general Sessions of the Peace Next to be Holden at Concord, in & for the County of Middlesex, in March Next & so on to any other Court, to Oppose the acceptance of a Road Laid out by a Court Committee, from Stow River to Lt. Abijah Brigham, — Do. or act &c &c —
