- 10th To see, if the Town, will remit, to the several Owners, or Keepers of Dogs, the Tax arising in Consequence of their not Making a Return, to the Assessor, on or before the first Day of April, agreeable to a Law of this Common Wealth and to appropriate, the Remainder of said Tax.
- 11th To see, if the Town, will go in to the Measure of Hiring their Collectors, to collect the Town Taxes, the present year, Do. or act &c.
- 12th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for widening the Road (Agreeable to the Original Laying out) from Tho^s. Dabrymple, across the Pine Plains, to Lancaster Road, near Peter Haynes Do. or act &c. &c. &c.
