Sudbury Monday April 1st 1799. —
The above Notification, has been posted, up by the desire
of the Selectmen, & agreeable, to a former vote of the Town —

Warning Accepted, by the Town Vote, —
At a Legal Town Meeting, held in Sudbury, on Monday, the
1st Day of April 1799. — It was Moved & seconded, To see,
if the Town would put by the choice of Gov^r & Gov^rs & Sena-
tors, for the space of half an hour, in order that the Town
might be more generally assembled, which being put to
Vote passed in the Affirmative. — Then the Town took
2^d up the 2^d Article, and made choice of Col^l. Jona-
thon Rice, for their Moderator. — The 6th Article, in
the Warning of March Meeting as contain'd in this 2^d Ar-
ticle Accepted, the Settlement, of the Selectmen, with the
Town Treas^r. & ordered the same to be recorded, —
8th Article, as contain'd in this 2^d Article, Voted to pass over
this Article, — 11th Article, as contain'd in this 2^d
Article, Voted, that that the Business Respecting buying Collec-
tion, to Collect the Town Taxes, as Mentioned in this Article
be put by, untill 6 o'clock this Afternoon, then to be Ac-
