Then the Town by Vote, made Choice of Capt. Daniel Brown as Constable, for the North Ward, & made Choice of Mr. John Brown, as Constable, for the South Ward. in said Town, - which were, each of them, sworn, to the faithful Discharge, of their office, by the Clerk of said Town in open Town Meeting

12th Article, as Contained in this 2^d Article after a Considerable time spent, in debating, upon what is Contained, in this article - it was by the Vote, of the Town put over to May Meeting

4th Article Voted, to Choose a Committee, of three persons, for the purpose of ascertaining the Bound Round the training field, in said Town, & Mr. Ebenezer Plympton, Mr. William Hunt, Jr. & Mr. James Carter, were appointed, for the above purpose

~~5th Article Voted, to appoint a Committee, of three persons, for the purpose of erecting a shed, to shelter the funeral Carriage & also of appropriating the old building made Choice of Mr. John Brigham, Dr. Thomas Watson, & Mr. Daniel Osborn, to proceed to the business of erecting said shed~~

~~also voted that said shed be erected upon the Common Land on a suitable spot of ground, near the training field in said Town~~

Then the Town by their Vote, adjourn'd this Meeting to Mr. Roland Cutler, to Mat this Evening Monday Evening April 1st the Town being not agreeable to the aforesaid adjournment, provided, to seal up the Return, ~~to the~~ of the Votes, for the Choice of Gov. L. Gov. & Senators, for the year ensuing
