at the State-House, in Boston, on Wednesday the 29<sup>th</sup> Day  
of May Next, - Agreeable to a Law, of this Common-wealth,  
in that Case, made & provided  
2<sup>d</sup> To Chose a Moderator, & act upon the 12<sup>th</sup> Article in the  
Warning of March Meeting, & Refer'd to April Meeting, & so  
from April Meeting, Refer'd to May Meeting, for further considera-  
tion  
3<sup>d</sup> To see, if the Town, will appropriate, the sum of six  
Dollars, out of the unappropriated Money now in the  
Treasury
