Done by Peter Smith, whilst Boarding with said Rich-
-ardson, and if it is thought obtainable, that the Town
Indemnify Capt. Wheeler, in the Process, against said
Richardson, —

— Attended to the report, of the Committee, appointed for
the purpose of staking out the Ground, whereon to erect
the Stables upon — which report is as follows, — that
said Committee had set up a Stake & Stones, at the South
East corner of Lt. Willins Stables, a Strait Line to a
Stake & Stones, at the North East corner of the Meeting-
-House, said Line, being about thirty five feet, Back of said
Meeting-House, — which Report was accepted, —
Then the Town by their Vote, Dissolved, this Meeting.
