4th Article - Then the Town Voted, to adjourn this Meeting, for a few
 Minutes, for the purpose of Viewing the ground, whereon to E-
 rect Stables, upon

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing adjourn-
 ment, provided, & took up the 4th Article again, & Voted -
 that Dr. Noyes, & Others, as Mentioned in this Article, be di-
 rected, to Erect the front of their Stables 36 feet North of the
 Meeting-House, in a straight Line, as the Bounds are Now
 Erected - also Voted that Dr. Noyes & Others, should have
 the Liberty, to Erect their Stables, upon the ground, near a
 Great Rock, at the North-Westerly End of said Meeting House.
