3^d To see, if the Town, will grant Money, for the support of a grammar school, the year ensuing, & Order where the same shall be kept, -- Do or, not, &c &c in

4th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the support of a Reading school, the year ensuing & Order where the same shall be kept, -- Do or not, &c &c in

5th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, for the Relief of the Poor, in said Town, the year ensuing in

6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Treasurer, & Assessors, the present year, in

7th To see, if the Town will take Measures, for Building a School-House, in ^{some} suitable place, in the North west District, in said Town, in Do or not, &c &c in

8th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for Building a School-House, in some suitable place, in the South west District in said Town, Do or not, &c &c in

9th To see, if the Town, will take some prudent Measures, for providing a School-House, for the South East district in said Town, Do or not, &c &c in

10th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable Persons, for a School Committee, for said Town, (Do or not, &c &c in)
