- 11th To see, if the Town, will take some suitable Measures for coming into some agreement with their Rev^d Minister Respecting the Ministerial Woodland, in said Town Do - or act. &c &c
- 12th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for coming in to an Agreement with the Town of Westminster for the support of Sally Cutter Daughter of Josiah Cutter, which they say belong to the Town of Sudbury Do or act.
- 13th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for widening the Road, Called Lancaster Road West of Mr. Peter Haynes, as far up as shall be thought Necessary, Do or act.
- 14th To see, if the Town, will take some prudent Measures for disposing of the Land left for a Highway, it being a part of the Westerly thirty Rod Highway (so called) in said Town, from the Post Road, to Frammingham Line Do - or act. &c &c
- 15th To see, if the Town, will appoint, an agent, or agents, to appear at the Court of General Sessions of the peace Next to be holden at Cambridge, in & for the County of Middlesex, & so on to any Other Court, or Courts, to oppose the acceptance of a Road, Laid out by a Courts Committee from Stow Line to Lint. Abijah Brigham, - & also to oppose the acceptance of a Report of a Committee for Laying out a Road, from Lint. Abijah Brigham to Joseph Russell, of Weston, if any such report should be made, Do or act. &c &c
- 16th To see, if the Town, will appoint an agent, or agents, to appear at the Court of General Sessions of the peace, Next to be holden at Cambridge in & for the County of Middlesex, & so on to any other Court, or Courts, to oppose the Laying out, or acceptance of a Road, laid out, by a Courts Committee, Near Mr. John Browns, in the southerly part of said Town, Do - or act. &c &c
- 17th To see, if the Town, will call upon the Committee for Report, appointed for the purpose of helping to build the Bridge Over Stow River, Near Mr. Benjamin Smiths Mills Do - or act. &c &c
