At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury on Monday, the 14th Day of October, 1799. Proceeded to the business of said Day, & made choice of M^r. William Hunt, Jr. for their Moderator.

2^d Article Granted the sum of \$ 246. 66, 7¹/₂ as a salary, to the Rev^d. M^r. Biglow, for the year ensuing 246, 66, 7¹/₂

Then the Town, by their Vote, passed over the Last Clause of this 2^d Article for the present.

3^d Granted, the sum of \$ 200. for the support, of a Grammar School, the year ensuing, to be equally Divided, Between the five School Districts 200,

4th Granted, the sum of \$ 200. for the support of a Reading & writing School, the year ensuing to be equally Divided Between the five School Districts 200,
