8th Article, The Question was put to see if the Town would
Build a School House, in the South-West District in
said Town & it passed in the Negative.

9th Then the Town, Took up the 9th Article again &
Voted, to Choose a Com^{tee} of three Persons, for the pur-
-pose of Viewing the School House, belonging to certain
Proprietors, in the South-East District in said Town,
& purchasing if they can agree with said propri-
-ators, and if they shall think said House, will an-
-swer the Towns purpose for a School House, & to
make their report to the Town at the ad^ojour-
-nment of this Meeting, - Committee Chosen
were M^r. Samuel Jones, Lt. Abijah Brigham, and
Liq^r. Rice.

11th Voted, to choose of Com^{tee} of three Persons, for the
purpose of Confering with their Rev^d. Minister with
Regard to coming in to some agreement respect-
-ing the Ministerial Woodland as mentioned in
this Article & the following Persons were Chosen,
Viz^t. Liq^r. Rice Capt Goodnow, & M^r. Thomas Rice
also Voted said Com^{tee} make their Report, at the ad-
-journment of this Meeting.

14th The Town, by their Vote, Directed the Selectmen
to Proceed & View the Land Left for a Highway
as mentioned in this Article, & if they should
find any Land Belonging to said Town, that
they Dispose of said Land in such a way, as
