15th Article, Voted to appoint one person as an agent to appear
at the Court of General Sessions of the Peace Next to be holden
at Cambridge, in & for the County of Middlesex & so on to any
other Court or Courts, for the purpose Express in this Ar-
-ticle, & Cap^t. Joseph Goodnow was appointed, & Empro-
-wered to act in Behalf of said Town, for the purposes
Above Mentioned — — — — —

16th Article, Passed Over for the present, — — — — —
17th Article, Passed over, — — — — —

18th Granted, the sum of \$ 40. 66. for the purpose of C. M.
of taking up some outstanding Orders, in said Town, 40. 66..

19th The Town by their Vote, Directed the selectmen,
to agree ^{with} some suitable Person to do the Busi-
-ness Mentioned in this Article, — — — — —

Then the Town, by their Vote, Adjourned this
Meeting to this Day fortnight, at, 1 o'clock, Af-
-ternoon, to Meet, at this Place, — — — — —

Sabbury, Monday, Nov^r. 11th. 1799, — — — — —

The Town being Mett, agreeable to the foregoing ad-
-journment, provided, to the Business of said Day

— The Question was then put, to see, if the Town
17th would take up the 17th Article again, & it passed
in the Negative — — — — —

9th the Committee, appointed for the purpose of Viewing
the School-House, in the South-East District, in said
Town, Reported — that the purchase, & repairing
said school-House, would not Amount to more than
one half the sum, it would Cost to Build a New
House, if it would Give satisfaction, & would ac-
-commodate the District. — After a Consider-
-able time spent in Debating upon ^{the} subject, Mat-
-ter of said School-House, the report was Not, accep-
-ted. —

124 — Then the Town, took up the 9th Article again
9th & the Question was put to see, if the Town
would Build a School-House, in the South East
District in said Town & it passed in the Affir-
-mative —
