Smiths Mills, for Certain reasons to be offered to said Town, when Mett. - agreeable to the Petition of M^r. Isaac Puffer & others Do or act. &c. &c. -
- 4th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable Sum of Money to enable their Committee, to proceed to the Building a Part of the Bridge, over Stow River, Near M^r. Benjamin Smiths Mills, (agreeable to the Towns Vote, past at the Last Town Meeting) - Do or act. &c. &c. -
