At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on Monday
the 2^d Day of Dec^r. 1799, Proceeded to the Business of said
Day, & made Choice of Mr. William Hunt J^r for their Moderator.
2^d Article, after a Considerable time spent in Discussing upon the
Subject Matter of this article, — The Question was put to see,
if the Town, would discontinue the Road through Lt. Israel
Smiths Land, to Mr. Benj^a Smiths Mills, as Mentioned in
this Article, & it Passed, in the Negative —
3^d Article, Vote, Not to Do, Nor act, any thing upon this Article —
4th The Town, by their Vote, Granted the Sum of \$ 60, for the
Purpose of Enabling their Committee appointed for the
purpose of Building a Bridge, over Elizabeth River, near Mr.
Benj^a Smiths Mills, to proceed to the Building said Bridge
— said Committee to be accountable to the Town, for
the Expenditure thereof — also Ordered their assessor —
to make said Grant into a Rate, forthwith. — \$ 60.
— Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved, this Meeting —
