These are to notify & warn, all the Freeholders & other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Meetinghouse in said Town, on Monday the 3^d day of March next at 1. O. Clock afternoon, on said day, Then & there —

1st. To choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, selectmen Town Treasurer, Assessors, Constables and all other Town Officers required by law to be annually chosen in the months of March or April — — — — —

2^d. To see if the Town will repair their Highways by a Rate, the present year, & grant a suitable sum of money for repairing the same. — — — — —

3^d. To see if the Town will give liberty for swine to go at large the present year. — — — — —

4th. To see if the Town will give liberty for horses, to go at large without fetters any part of the present year from the first day of April, to the last day of Sept. — — — — —

5th. To see if the Town will give liberty for sheep to go at large from the 15th day of March to the first day of May next. — — — — —

6th. To see if the Town will except the settlement of the select men, with the Town Treasurer and order the same to be recorded. — — — — —

7th. To see if the Town direct some suitable spot of Ground whereon to erect the schoolhouse in the Northwest District in said Town, Do or act as the Town shall think best when met. — — — — —

8th. To see if the Town will except of the road made by M^r. Jon^s. Smith, in lieu of the old road which his new House now stands upon do, or act &c. — — — — —

9th. To see if the Town will discontinue & sell any part of the road that is now curbed by M^r. Jon^s. Smith leading by said Smith's through Cor. Taylor's place (so called) do, or act &c. — — — — —

10th. To see if the Town will agreeable to the request of S^t. Hephiah Smith exempt him from paying his proportion toward. — — — — —
