These are to notify and warn all the Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury qualified by Law as provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth to vote for Governor, Lieut. Governor and Senators; Also all other Inhabitants of said Town qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town Affairs, to meet at the meeting-house in said Town on Monday the 7th day of April next at 1 O'clock in the afternoon on said day then and there - - -

- 1st To bring in their votes for Governor, Lieut. Governor and Senators for the year ensuing.
- 2^d To choose a Moderator, and to fill such vacancies, if any there be, in Town Officers as the Law requires to be annually chosen in in the months of March or April, also to act upon the 6th 7th 8th 9th & 10th Articles in the warning of March meeting and referred to April meeting
- 3^d To see if the Town will take measures for hiring collectors to collect the Taxes in said Town the ensuing year, Do, or not &c.
- 4th To see if the Town will appoint a place whereon to erect the new schoolhouse in the southeast District, Do, or act &c.
- 5th To see if the Town will take measures for the sale of the old schoolhouse in the Northwest District, Do, or act, &c.
- 6th To see if the will empower a person or persons to give Mr. Adam How a new Deed of his Pew in the meeting house in said Town, he having lost the original, Do, or act &c.
- 7th To see if the Town will take measures for paying Mr.
