Then proceeded to fill vacancies and Mr. Abner Walker having sent in a request to be excused the town by their vote excused him and made choice of Mr. Paul Walker for Highway surveyor in the southwest Ward in lieu of said Abner Walker. Mr. Roland Cutler came forward and wished to be excused from serving the Town as Pound keeper, and was by vote of the Town excused, and St. Arenten Rice Schafers in his stead. Then the Town put by choosing Constables till after Collectors were appointed. Then proceeded to the

III Voted to let out the collecting the Taxes in said Town the year ensuing to the lowest Bidder on the pound, hear they who should bid it off ~~giving~~ procuring sufficient Bondsmen to indemnify the Town. It was accordingly put up at public Vendue, and Capt. Daniel Bowker being the lowest bidder undertook to collect all the Taxes assessed on the inhabitants in the North Ward for three pence three farthings on the pound. And Mr. John Brown being the lowest Bidder undertook to collect all the Taxes assessed on the inhabitants in the South Ward for three pence three farthing on the pound, both for the year ensuing. Then
