- I** To choose a Moderator, and act upon the 6th and 9th, Articles in the Warning of March meeting, and refered to April and from April to May meeting, Also to act upon the 6th Article in the Warning of April meeting and refered to May meeting. Do, or Not &c
- II** To all if the Town will appoint an Agent or Agents to appear at the Court of Common Pleas next to be holden at Concord in and for the County of Middlesex and so on to any other Court or Courts to defend said Town in a suit brought by the select men of Concord against said Town of Sudbury for the support of Peter Smith. Do, or Not &c
- III** To all if the Town will appoint an Agent or Agents to appear in behalf of said Town for the purpose of defending said Town against any suit that may be brought for the support of Campers the present year. Do, or Not, &c
- IV** To all if the Town will accept of and confirm an alteration made by the select men in the Road leading by Col. Jonathan Rice's called Lancaster Road Do, or Not, &c
- V** To all if the Town will open the Road or any part of it near Mr. Abraham Smith's which is now closed. Do, or Not, &c
- VI** To all if the Town will attend to the Report of the Committee chosen for the purpose of ascertaining the Bounds round the training field in said Town near Mr. John Clark's, also to see if the Town will take measures to prevent any wood being cut from said field Do, or Not, &c
