

May Anno Domini 1800

Sudbury Monday May 13th 1800

At A Legal Town meeting of the inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury convened at the Place and Time before mentioned proceeded to the Business of said Day

The Question was taken to see if the Town would send a Representative to represent them at the General Court appointed to be convened and held at Boston on the last Wednesday in the present month and it passed in the affirmative

And Col. Jonathan Rice Esq. being a Resident & freeholder in said Town was chosen to represent said Town at the Court above said having the number of 39 Votes

Then the Town proceed to transact the remaining business of said day and proceeded as follows

- I** Made choice of Col. Jonathan Rice Moderator, Then took up the 6th Article in the warrant for March meeting and referred to April meeting and from April referred to May meeting, and voted to accept of the settlement of the select men with the Treasurer and ordered the same to be recorded
- 9th Article in the Warrant of March meeting referred to April meeting and from April to May meeting as contained in this first Article, Passed in the Negative
- 6th Article in the Warrant for April meeting & referred to May meeting as contained in the first article in this meeting, voted to appoint a Committee for the purpose of giving Mr. Adam How a new Deed of his Pew in the new meeting house in Sudbury and the former Committee chosen by said Town for giving Deeds of Pews in said meeting house were appointed & empowered to give said How a new Deed in the same form and manner as the one first given to his father Col. Ezechiel How

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
