II Voted to choose two Agents for the Purposes contained in this Article, Col. Jonathan Rice and Capt. Mahel Wheeler were chosen and empowered to act jointly or severally on all matters relating to this Article

III Voted to choose two Agents for the Purposes contained in this Article, Col. Jonathan Rice and Capt. Mahel Wheeler were chosen and empowered to act jointly or severally as occasion may require in all purposes mentioned in this Article

IV Voted that the Town have no objection to the alteration being made in the Road called Lancaster Road near Col. Jonathan Rice's as stated by the Selectmen and order the Highway surveyor in the same Ward viz. Mr. Micah Balcom together with Mr. Mahel Balcom and Mr. Daniel Puffer to be a Committee to determine when said Rice has made said new Road as good as the old one, and then the Highway Surveyor in said Ward to work on the new road in lieu of the old one

V Voted that the Road which is now curbed near Mr. Abraham Smith's be laid open in the manner following viz. beginning at a sett of Bars north of said Smith's dwelling house thence running a northeasterly course till it comes out to the road that is now open

VI Voted that the Committee chosen on the 5th day of April 1799 for the purpose of ascertaining the Bounds round the training field near Mr. John Clark's in said Town proceed and ascertain said Bounds, and take measures to prevent any wood being cut from said field.

Then the Town attended to the report of the Committee chosen to fix on a place to erect the new schoolhouse in the south east District which is as follows that said schoolhouse be erected on the same spot where the old one stood owned by certain proprietors, extending north, east and south far enough to commodate said building - this report was accepted by the vote of the Town
