II. It was moved and seconded to see if the Town would do any thing towards the support of the Militia agreeable to the Warrant for this meeting and it passed in the affirmative

Again it was moved and seconded to see if the Town would grant to each soldier, who appeared on the field agreeable to orders in complete uniform, nine shillings to be spent agreeable to the warrant and it passed in the negative

Again it was moved and seconded to see if the Town would request the Militia Officers present
