VIII So see if the Town will grant a sum of Money for the purpose of hiring a suitable person to teach a singing school in said Town the present year agreeable to the petition of Gen. Benjamin Sawin & others, Do, or, act, &c.

IX So see if the Town will open the whole or any part of the Road that is now curbed near Mr. Abraham Smith's Do, or, act, &c.

X So see if the Town will take any measures for aiding themselves of the support of Sally Cutler, Do, or, act, &c.

XI So see if the Town will take any measures for ascertaining the bounds around a spot of ground near Mr. Gideon Richardson's, said to be left for a burying ground. Also to see if the Town will rebuild the monument on said ground & place a handsome stone on the same & engrave the name of Gen. Washington and as much of the character of that great man as the Town shall think direct, agreeable to the petition of Gen. Sawin, Do, or, act, &c.

XII So see if the Town will grant money to defray the Expenses of Building the schoolhouse in the north-west & south-west District, Do, or, act, &c.

XIII So see if the Town will take measures for building a schoolhouse in some suitable place in the south-west District in said Town, Do, or, act, &c.

XIV So see if the Town will choose some suitable persons not being the select men for a school Committee the year ensuing, Do, or, act, &c.

XV So see if the Town will give the old school house in the south-east District to Mr. John Graves for the purpose of repairing his dwelling house, agreeable to the request of Mr. John Graves, Do, or, act, &c.
