Voted to adjourn this meeting to the first Monday of Nov. next at 1 O'clock P.M. to meet at this place
Sudbury Monday November 3^d 1800 said Town being met according to adjournment proceeded to business

II It was motioned & seconded to see if the Town would take up the 2^d article again & it passed in the affirmative — and the Town voted to grant to their Reverend Minister \$86.67 as a gratuity the present year

XII Put over to the adjournment again

XIII Put over to the adjournment

Granted the sum of \$30 for the Purpose of defraying the expence of a case now pending in Law between the Towns of Concord & Sudbury on account of Peter Smith the Committee to be accountable for the expenditure of the same

XVII The Town by their vote took up the 17th article and voted to accept of the report of the Committee chosen to view the road mentioned in this article, and likewise the proposals of Messrs. John Brown & Wm. Walcutt upon their fulfilling their proposals, said Committee are empowered to take an Obligation for the binding of said parties & convey the same before the next Court to the Treasurer — The report of said Committee is ^{that} the agent chosen to make oppositions to the acceptance of said road desist from opposing if said proposals are fulfilled reference being had to the obligation which shall be given —

Voted to adjourn this meeting to this day fortnit, to meet at this place at 1 O'clock P.M.
Sudbury Monday November 17th 1800 said Town having met according to the aforesaid adjournment proceeded to business —

and voted that the Treasurer discount to Deacon Thomas Walker all the accounts allowed to him by vote of the Town —

XV Passed in the negative

XIII Voted to build a school house in the south west school District, and choose three persons as a Committee for the purpose of letting out and superintending the building said house
