

March Anno Domini 1801

There are to notify & warn all the freeholders & other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to vote, in Town affairs to Meet at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 2^d Day of March Next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon then & there to act on the following article, Vizt. —

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treasurers, Assessors, Constables & all other Town Officers, Required by Law, to be annually chosen, in the Months of March or April —
- 2^d To see if the Town, will repair their Highway, by a Rate the present year & grant a suitable sum of Money for repairing the same —
- 3^d To see, if the Town, will give liberty for swine to go at Large the present year —
- 4th To see, if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at Large, without fetters, any part of the present year, from the first Day of April, to the Last Day of September, —
- 5th — To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for sheep to go at Large, from the 15th Day of March to the first Day of May Next, —
- 6th To see, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the selectmen with the Town Treasurer, & order the same to be recorded, —
- 7th To see, if the Town, will take Measures, for hiring Collectors, to collect the Taxes in said Town the ensuing year, Do or, act &c. —
- 8th To see, if the Town, will direct some suitable spot of Ground, whereon to erect the School House in the South West district in said Town, Do or act &c. —
- 9th To see, if the Town, will choose some suitable person, for a School Committee, the year ensuing —
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ing, & authorize them to procure School Teachers agreeable to the request of W^m Rice Esq^r. Do or, act &c.
