7th Article Voted to Let out the Collecting the Taxes in said Town to such person or persons, as will do it the Lowest on the Pound. He - or They Promising good & sufficient Bondsmen, to Indemnify the Town, - It was then put up at public Vendue, & L^t. Sam^l. & Puffer J^r. being the Lowest Bidders Engaged to collect the Taxes Assessed upon the Inhabitants of the North Ward in said Town, at four Pence on the Pound, & M^r. Ezekiel. How Loring being the Lowest Bidder, Engaged to collect the Taxes in the South Ward in said Town at four Pence on the Pound - Then the Town by their Vote, Made choice of L^t. Sam^l. & Puffer J^r. as Constables for the North Ward, & M^r. Ezekiel How Loring Constable for the South Ward, for the year

Ensuing - each of them who have since been sworn to the faithful Discharge of their office - by the Clerk of said Town,

8th Article Voted to choose a Committee, for the purpose of directing a suitable spot of ground, whereon to erect the School-House, in the South-west District in said Town, - also Voted, that said Committee, make their report to the Town, of their proceedings thereon, at April Meeting, said Committee to consist of three Persons - Com^{tee} appointed were Esq^r. Rice then Esq^r. Rice was Excluded from serving on said Com^{tee}, & M^r. William Hurst J^r. was chosen - in his Room Reuben Maynard, was then chosen - then Reuben Maynard, was Excused from serving on said Com^{tee}, & Esq^r. Rice & Major Jonas Holder, & Col^o. Jonathon Rice were appointed.

9th Voted to Choose a School-Committee as Express in this Article - said Com^{tee} to consist of five persons, One of out of each School-district, & the following Gent^l were appointed (Viz^t) William Rice Esq^r. M^r. Hope Brown Col^o. Jon^l. Rice & Capt. Isaac Gibbs, & Capt. Joseph Goodnow, - It was then Voted, that there be an addition of two persons more on this Com^{tee}, & M^r. Asahel Wheeler J^r. & Doct^r. Snider, were appointed - also - Voted to Refer the remainder part, of this Article to April Meeting, for further Consideration
