 - 3^d To fill up vacancies, in those Town Offices, which the
Law requires, should any Office appear to be vacant,
 - 4th To see, if the Town will give any Encouragement, to such
Persons, as shall destroy the Crows in said Town, - Do-
or act as the Town shall think proper when Met,
 - 5th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for Erect-
ing of some kind of Guides, upon this Towns propo-
-tion, of the Long Causeway, - Do - or act & c.
 - 6th To see, if the Town will, Agreeable to the request of M^r.
Eben. Plympton, Grant to him a suitable sum of
Money, to Compensate him for a Road Laid out thro-
