At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on Monday the 12th Day of Oct^r 1801. Proceeded to the business of said Day, 1st & Made choice of, Colo. Jonathon Rice, for their Moderator.

2^d Granted, the Sum of \$246⁶⁶⁷, as a Salary, to their Pres^d Minister, the year ensuing

The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town would make an additional Grant, to their Pres^d Minister of the sum of \$86⁶⁶⁷, & it passed ^{the} Negative. It was then Voted, that their should No Vote, be delord, a Vote ~~except~~ by the Moderator Except it is his Opinion, there is a Majority of the Voters present, are in favour of it

3^d & 4th Articles, Granted the Sum of \$500, for the support of Public Schools in said Town the year ensuing, to be Equally divided between the five School Districts

Also by their Vote appropriated, the sum of \$375 - out of the Grant of \$500 for the purpose of supporting the Winter School, to be equally Divided
