

October Anno Domini 1801.

10th Article, The Town by their Vote, appointed three persons as a Committee, to confer, & agree with M^r. Luther Goodnow, respecting the damages he has sustained by the alteration of a County road laid out through his land, and report to the Town, at the adjournment of this Meeting — Committee appointed were, M^r. Hope Brown, M^r. Isaac Puffer, & M^r. Silas Conant — Then the Town, at M^r. Brown's desire exempted him from serving on the above S^d. Committee, & Bryⁿ. Josiah Richardson, was appointed in his stead.

11th Then the Town, by their Vote, appointed a Committee of three Persons for the purpose of viewing & finding out a shorter a better, & a less expensive way for a road, than that which is now laid out & accepted, from the Rev^d. M^r. Biglow, as far as M^r. Towers, & report to the Town their proceedings at the adjournment of this Meeting — Committee appointed, were Deacon Tho^s. Walker, M^r. John Brigham, & Asahel Balcom.

Then the Town by their Vote, adjourn'd this Meeting to this day three weeks, at 1 o'clock, Afternoon — to meet at this place.

Sudbury Monday Nov^r. 2^d. 1801.

The Town, being well agreeable to the foregoing adjournment, Proceeded & took up the

6th Article, & Granted, the sum of \$10. .. to pay their Treas^r. S. C. M^r.
for his services, the present year, 10. ..

9th Passed Over for the present.

10th Attended to the report of the Committee appointed for the purpose of conferring & agreeing with M^r. Luther Goodnow, — who reported that they could not come into any agreement, with M^r. Goodnow, respecting the damages he has, or may sustain, on account of the alteration of the road, being laid out through his Land.

Then the Town, on the one part, & M^r. Luther Goodnow, on the other, Mutually agreed upon three Persons, as Referees, Viz^t. Colo^d. Roger Brown,
