Biglow's, as far as against Esq. Rice's, - Committee appointed, were William Rice Esq. & Capt. Joseph Goodnow, also empowered said Committee, to act either jointly or separately, in behalf of said Town, in business - matters shall render necessary.

9th Article, Then the Town took up the 9th Article again, & the Question being put, to see, if the Town, would accept of the road, as Laid out by the Selectmen, as express in this Article, & it passed in the Negative.

Then the Town by their vote, adjourned this Meeting to this Day three weeks, at 1 o'clock Afternoon, to meet, at this place,

Jonathon Fairbank, for one Quarter of an Acre of land, or More, upon which the ^{New} School-House in the South West district stands upon some part thereof, - also Voted that the Selectmen, take a Deed, in behalf of the Town, of said School-House plat, & Give said Fairbank an Order, for said sum, when they Receive the above-mentioned Deed	\$	C.
