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Granted, the sum of \$65.00 for the purpose of compensating to the Owners of the Land, East of Mr. Luther Goodnow & adjoining S. Goodnow for the Road Laid out through his Land, by a Courts Com ^{tee} it being the sum assessed for Damages by said Committee	65		
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Granted, the sum of \$80.00 to pay the Assessors for their services, of taking the Valuation, & settling the Invoice agreeable to an act of the General Court, it being for Eighty Days Labour, at One Dollar p ^r . Day	80		
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6 th Article Granted the sum of \$10.00 to pay their Assessors the present year	10
