These are to Notify & Warn, all the Freeholders & Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Monday the 1st day of March next, at 9 o'clock forenoon on said Day, then and there, to act on the following Articles, Viz^t.

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r. Assessors, Constables, & all other Town Officers Required by law, to be annually chosen, in the Months of March, or April —
- 2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highway, by a Rate, the present year, and grant a suitable sum of Money, for repairing the same, —
- 3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Swine to go at large, the present year, —
- 4th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Horses to go at Large, without fetters any part of the present year, from the 1st day of April, to the last day Sept^r.
