Selectmen, to notify, & Meet, the Selectmen, of the Town of  
Now, for the purpose of erecting Bound & establishing the Line  
Between said Towns agreeable to the survey, & plan made  
of the Town, as surveyed, & return'd into the Office of the  
Secretary, of the Common-wealth.

2<sup>d</sup> Article, Attended, to the report of the Com<sup>tee</sup> appointed for the  
purpose of hearing what propositions might be made, by M<sup>r</sup>.  
Abel Cutlar, & others. Reported, that M<sup>r</sup>. Cutlar was willing  
to contribute twenty five dollars p<sup>r</sup>. year, towards his support,  
or fifty Dollars, to be paid by the Town, & take him & support  
him, himself, per year — or he was willing to relinquish  
all his right & title, as Creditor to the Estate of Lt. Ruben  
Rice, Dec<sup>d</sup>, if the Town would take & support, said Micah  
Rice, together they further reported, it was the desire of M<sup>r</sup>. Cutlar, together  
with M<sup>r</sup>. Nath<sup>l</sup>. & Ben<sup>y</sup>. Rice, that their might be a Com<sup>tee</sup>  
appointed & empowered, by the Town, to Meet, and agree  
with M<sup>r</sup>. Cutlar & come to a final Settlement, Respect-  
ing the supporting of the said Micah,

Then the Town by their Vote (after they had heard the re-  
port of their Com<sup>tee</sup> appointed for the purpose of hearing  
what propositions M<sup>r</sup>. Abel Cutlar, & others, would make res-  
pecting the contributing to the support of Micah Rice,) Dis-  
cuss'd the Selectmen to make application to the Judge of Probates  
for a Letter of administration, upon the Estate of M<sup>r</sup>. Nath<sup>l</sup>.  
Rice, of Sudbury, Deceased,

It was then Mov'd & seconded, & pass'd by a Vote, that  
the Selectmen be directed, to hear & attend, to the propositions  
of M<sup>r</sup>. Abel Cutlar, or any other person or persons, shall  
make, respecting the support of Micah Rice & if said pro-  
posals, shall appear to them to be for the Interest of the  
Town, to accept of. — Then they are hereby authorized to  
agree with, & make a final Settlement with said Cut-  
lar &c. — or if they cannot come into any agreement  
that shall appear to them, to be for the Towns Interest  
then to proceed, as before directed, for a Letter of admini-  
stration, upon the Estate, of M<sup>r</sup>. Nath<sup>l</sup>. Rice, Deceased,
