- = The Question was then ask'd to see, if the Town would give M^r Luther Goodnow, \$3. 60 per Rod for him to make the road, that was Lay'd out through his Land &c. &c. & it pass'd in the Negative ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
- = The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town would Empower the old Com^{tee} to let out the whole of the road either in gross, or in Lots, as to them shall appear, most for the Interest of the Town, - & it pass'd in the Negative
