

October Anno Domini 1802

There are to Notify & warn, all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House in said Town, on Monday the 4th Day of Oct^r next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, on said day to act on the following Articles: Viz^t

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, & bring in Town Debts & Credit
- 2^d To see, if the Town will grant, to their Rev^d Minister his Salary, for the year ensuing, & also to make an additional grant, to their Rev^d Minister to do or act, as the Town shall think best when Met.
- 3^d To see, if the Town will grant Money, for the support of a Grammar School the year ensuing & Order where the same shall be kept - do or act &c
- 4th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the support of a Reading & writing school, - the year ensuing & Order where the same shall be kept, do or act &c
- 5th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money for the Relief of the Poor in said Town, the year ensuing
- 6th To see, if the Town, will Grant Money, to pay their Treasurer, & Assessors, the present year, do or act &c
- 7th To see, if the Town will appoint some suitable person, to take care of, & sweep the Meeting House ring - the Bell, & Dig Graves, as Occasion may Require the year ensuing - do or act &c &c &c
- 8th To see, if the Town will take any Measures for Opening & making the road, through the Lands of M^r Luther Goodnow, & Others, as Layd out, & accepted, by a Courts Committee, in May term 1801 do or act &c
- 9th To see, if the Town, will Grant a suitable sum of Money for the further Repairs, of their Highways the present year. (do or act &c &c)
- 10th To see if the Town, will take any Measures for defraying the expense, that has arisen in consequence of an action, brought by the Town of Concord, against the Town of Sudbury, for the support of Peter Smith, do or act &c
