-day, the 1st day of Nov^r. 1802, Proceeded to the busi-
-ness of said day, by bringing in their votes, to the se-
-lection ^{the choice of} of a Federal Representative, as follows. Viz-

3^d The Question was then put, to see if the Town would ^(to)
Repair the south Butments, of Shermans Bridge (so called)
with stone, & it pass'd in the affirmative — also by
this vote appointed the selectmen, to be a Committee
for the purpose of Procuring said Stone & seeing the work
done, in such a manner, as shall appear to them, most
for the Interest of the Town, — Also by this vote,
= Granted, the sum of thirty dollars, for the Purpose of
Repairing the Butments abovemention'd, \$ 30. ..

4th The Question was asked to see, if the Town, would Grant the
sum of Forty dollars, for the purpose of making the Road
Mention'd in this Article, & it pass'd in the Negative, —
= The Question was again asked to see if the Town would Grant
the sum of \$ 40. for the purpose of making the abovemention-
= tion'd road & it again pass'd in the Negative — — —

5th Voted to appoint a Committee, for the purpose of ascer-
-taining the Bounds of the Highway, as express'd in this or-
-dinance, & to make their report to the Town at some future
-meeting, and the selectmen, was appointed, as a Com-
-mittee, for the Purpose abovemention'd, — — —
