Sudbury Monday, Decr. 13<sup>th</sup> 1802

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on the day and year aforesaid — Proceeded to the business of said Day. & took up the first Article, & made Choice of 1<sup>st</sup> M<sup>r</sup>. William Hunt, for their Moderator. —

2<sup>d</sup> After a Considerable discussion, had, upon the Subject Matter of this Article — The Question was put, to wit: — The Town would direct their Committee, appointed for the purpose of Letting out the making the Road mentioned in this Article, together with the Undertakers, — to suspend the Making said Road, untill such time as the Petitioners, for a Courts Committee, to Review the Petitions, may have an Opportunity, to be heard. — Provided the Town should be Indemnified, by said Petitioners, or any other Person, or persons, that the expenses of the making, & Purchasing the Land, for the new Proposed Road, should not be at any more ~~expense~~ expense to the Town, than the Laid out road. — Provided also, that the Undertakers, of the Laid out Road, be made good, for the trouble & Labour they have been at, and it passed in the Negative —

3<sup>d</sup> After a Considerable Debate, had, upon the Subject Matter of this Article — The Question was asked to wit: — if the Town, would grant, to Messieurs Neah & Sam<sup>l</sup> the Wholes, the sum of Thirty three dollars, it being the damages Assessed by a Courts Committee, for a road Laid out through their Lands, near M<sup>r</sup>. Silas Conants and it passed in the Negative —

Then the Town by their Vote Dissolved this Meeting — William Hunt } Moderator
