

March Anno Domini, 1803.

There are to Notify and warn, all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote, in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House, in said Town, on Tuesday the first day of March Next, at 9 o'clock in the forenoon on said day then & there to act on the following Articles Vizt.

1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas^r, Assessors, Constables, & all other Town Officers, required by Law, to be Annually chosen, in the Months of March or April

2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways by a rate the present year, & grant a suitable Sum of Money for Repairing the same.

3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Swine to go at Large, the present year.

4th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty, for Horses to go at large, without fetters, any part of the present year, from the first day of April, to the last day of September.

5th To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Sheep to go at Large, from the 15th day of March, to the 1st Day of May Next.

6th To see, if the Town, will accept the Settlement of the Selectmen, with the Town Treas^r & Order the same to be Recorded.

7th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, to Hire some suitable person, or persons, for Collector, or collectors, & ~~Jury~~ to collect the Town Taxes, the Town Taxes the year ensuing, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best when Met.

8th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable persons for a school Committee, & authorize them to agree with & Hire school Teachers, to teach said schools the year ensuing. Do or act, &c. &c.

9th To see if the Town will take any Measures, for defraying the expens^e, that has or may arise, in consequence of an action, Instituted by the Town of Concord, against the Town of Sudbury for the support of Peter Smith, do, or act, &c.
