Joseph Goodnow, M^r Ezechiel Parmenter, Lt Hopstee Willis - & Luit^l Caleb Wheeler, ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

9th The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town would review the Action, with the Town of Concord, Respecting the Support of Peter Smith, & it passed in the Affirmative ~ ~ ~

Also by their vote, appropriated the sum of \$100.00 dollars (which sum, was granted, in Oct^r last past, for the purpose of settling the Bill of cost, that was obtain^d by the Town of Concord ^{against the Town of Sudbury} for the support of Peter Smith) for the purpose of carrying on the Action of Review, with the Town of Concord ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

Also by their Vote, Empowered their former Agents Viz^t Col^l Rice & Capt^l Wheeler, which were appointed, for the purpose of carrying on the law suit against the Town of Concord for the support of Peter Smith, to Review the Action, as above mention^d & attend to it whilst pending ~ ~ ~

10th 11th & 12th Articles Ref^d to April Meeting, for further Consideration ~ ~ ~ ~ ~

Then the Town, by their Vote, Dissolved this Meeting ~ ~ ~
