These are to Notify, and warn, all the Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury, Qualified as is provided in the Constitution of this Commonwealth, to Vote, in the choice of Governor, Lieut. Gov^r & Senators, for the year ensuing

And all others, qualified, as the Law directs, to Vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting-House, in said Town on Monday the 4th Day of April Next, at 1 o'clock in the afternoon on said day, then & there, to act, on

the following Articles Viz^t —

- 1st To bring in their Votes, for Gov^r L^t Gov^r & Senators for the year ensuing —
- 2^d To Choose a Moderator, & act upon the 10th 11th & 12th Articles, in the Warning of March Meeting, & refer'd to April Meeting, for further Consideration. —
- 3^d To fill up Vacancies, in those Town Offices, which the Law requires, should any Office appear to be Vacant, —
- 4th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for defraying the expence of a demand, made by the Inhabitants of the Town of Concord against the Town of Sudbury, for the support of Rose Benson, (a Negro Woman) Now residing in said Town of Concord, to do, or act, as the Town, shall think best, when Met, —
- 5th To see, if the Town, will curb Lancaster Old Road (so called) Near where M^r Frazier, Now lives, during the ensuing Summer season, — agreeable to the request of M^r Obadiah Orborn, — do — or act, &c. —
- 6th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures, for disposing of the House Lott, & part of a Small Barn Now Standing on the premises, which were formerly ^{property of the} the Widow Mary Goodnow's Agreeable to the request of M^r Asa Willis, — do — or act &c. —
- 7th To see, if the Town, will attend, to any, or all the reports of their Committees, should any be disposed to make their Reports, — Do — or — act, &c. —
