- 1st Article Made choice of M^r. William Hunt for his Moderator
- 2^d The Town by their vote authorized their School-committee as mentioned in this article, to agree with & Hire School Instructors &c. to teach their public schools the year ensuing — also by their vote, accepted of the report made by their School-committee, the preceding year, respecting their Rules or — ders, & discipline, to be observed in each particular School, which said Rules, Orders, &c. &c. shall be established the — the present year, —
- 3^d It was voted, that the same encouragement be given to those persons who shall use the means for destroying Crows, as was given the year last past, also that they be under the same restrictions & Regulations, they was the year past.
- 4th The Town by their vote, appointed, & Empowered their Treas^r in behalf of the Town, to pass a Deed, of the sale of the House lot, and part of a Barn, (that was formerly the Widow Mary Goodnow's) as mentioned in this Article —
- 5th Attended to the report of the Comm^{tee} appointed for the purpose of Leasing or Selling the House lot & part of the Barn, that was formerly the Widow Mary Goodnow's, who reported, that they had sold said House lot, &c. &c. for the sum of Fifty dollars & twenty five cents \$50.25, —
- Also by their vote, directed their selectmen, to View & lay out a Road between M^r. Harris bank, & M^r. Dalrymple's, provided, that should not appear to be land left by the Town sufficient for a road — also directed their selectmen, to dispose of the land near to said Road, if any appears to belong to the Town, to the best advantage, for the Town, —
- Then the Town by their vote, adjourned this Meeting —
