At a legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on Monday the 20th Day of June 1803 — provided to the business of said day and made choice of M^r. William Hunt for their Moderator — —

2^d Article, Voted to Grant a certain Sum of Money for the purpose of repairing their Highways, & the sum of \$ 500 dollars was Granted, for that purpose, to be expended upon the two Public Roads ~~passing~~ Leading through said Town, Vizt. Worcester, & Lancaster roads, (so called) said grant to be made into a Tax & committed, into the Surveyors, of Highways hands, & they to give every person the privilege of working out his proportion of said grant, on said road, whenever they are required by said Surveyors — also Voted that the aforesaid grant be Laid out, under the direction of the Selectmen, — — — — —
