9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for defraying the Ex-
pense of Eben^r. Burbank and Naham Tower, in consequence
of their being now confined in Concord Goal, do or act &c &c

10th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for the
Purpose of compensating M^r. Jonathan Fairbank
for his building the School-House in the South-west
District, it being in consequence of his sustaining
a Loss, in building said house, - agreeable to the re-
quest of said Fairbank - do or act &c &c

11th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable sum of Mo-
ney, for the further encouragement, of hiring a Mas-
ter, to teach a singing School, in said Town the pre-
sent year, agreeable to the request of the singing
Society - do or act &c &c

12th To see if the Town, will accept of a Road, as Laid out
by the Selectmen, leading from the School-House in
the South-west district, to M^r. Jonathan Fairbanks -
do or act &c &c

13th To see, if the Town, ~~will~~ (agreeable to the request of M^r.
Ezekiel W Loring) ^{and Isaac} will discontinue or sell, the Lane
called & known, by the Name of Brimstone Lane, lead-
ing from the County Road, near said Loring, to Fram-
ingham line, do or act, &c &c

14th To see, if the Town (agreeable to the Request of Lt. Hon-
stee Willis) will grant a suitable sum of Money, for
the purpose of removing a Number of large Rocks in
the Great Road, near M^r. Gideon Maynard, Do or act &c

15th To see, if the Town, will grant a suitable sum of Money
for the purpose of refunding, to the Treas^r. the Money which
he has Borrowed, to pay the Town of Concord, for the sup-
port of Rose Benson - Do or act &c &c

16th To see if the Town, will (agreeable the Request of Lt. Abel
Smith) take any Measures, for widening the Road near the
Slough (called Curtis Slough) in the Northerly part of the Town, -
Do or act &c &c
