

October Anno Domini, 1803, in a

15th Granted, to the Treas^r. the Sum of \$74.70 for the purpose of Refunding to him the Money which he had borrowed, as mentioned in this Article. 74.70

16th Passed Over,

17th Voted, that it be Left discretionary with the selectmen for them to Rail the Causeway mentioned in this Article, as they shall think proper

18th Granted, the sum of \$50. for the purpose of Repairing the Bridges mentioned in this Article, with plank, timber, &c. necessary for said repairs 50

The Question, was then put, to see, if the Town, would Grant to M^r. Asa Puffer, the sum of \$100. it being for Land taken for a Road, passing through the Northern part of the ~~northern~~ Town, & it passed in the Negative

It was then Voted, to take up the 9th Article again & attend to the report of the Committee appointed for the purpose of carrying on the Law suit, between the Towns of Concord, & Sudbury — who reported, that they had attended upon the agents belonging to Concord, respecting settling said business, and that said agents, had made an offer of Relinquishing \$26. out of the Bill of costs, which they had obtained Judgment for, against said Town,

Then the Town Granted, the sum of \$200. for the purpose of enabling their agents to carry on the Law suit between the Towns of Concord & Sudbury, for the support of Peter Smith, said agents to be accountable to the Town for the expenditure thereof 200

It was Voted, that the deed of the School-House Platt in the North West district, be deposited, in the Treas^r. Office

11th Voted, to take up this 11th Article again, and appointed a Committee of three persons, for the purpose of procuring a Master, and seeing to the Laying out of the Money granted under this Article, & William Rice Esq^r. Capt. Sam^l. Puffer, & Capt. Isaac Gibbs were appointed, for that purpose

Allowed, To M^r. Eben^r. Plympton, for 34 feet White oak timber, 11, inches by 10, for Sharmans Bridge. \$4.12. 4.20
& 1/4th of Powder, \$1.12. 67

To M^r. Eben^r. Moore for 1 lb. of Powder

To M^r. Israel Maynard, for four white pine poles, to Rave Sharmans Bridge 4
