These are to Notify, & Warn, all the Freeholders, and other Inhabitants, of the Town of Sudbury Qualified as the Law directs, to Vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the Meeting House in said Town, On Monday the 5th Day of March Next, at 10 o'clock, in the forenoon, on said day, then & there, to act on the following Articles Vizt.

- 1st To Choose a Moderator, Town Clerk, Selectmen, Town Treas.^r, Apsessor, Constables, & all other Town Officers, required by Law, to be annually chosen, in the Months of March or April
- 2^d To see, if the Town, will repair their Highways, by a Rate, the present year, & Grant a suitable Sum of Money, for repairing the same
- 3^d To see, if the Town, will give Liberty for Swine to go at Large, the present year,
- 4th To see, if the Town will give Liberty for Horses to go at Large, without fetters, any part of the present year from the first day of April, to the last day of September,
