

March Anno Domini 1804.

5th To see, if the Town, will give liberty, for sheep to go at large from the 15th Day of March to the first day of May next.

6th To see, if the Town, will accept the settlement of the selectmen with the Town Treas^r. & Order the same to be Recor^ded.

7th To see, if the Town, will appoint some suitable person for a school-committee & authorize them, to agree with & Hire School Instructors, to instruct the public schools, in said Town, the year ensuing to do or act as the Town shall think best when Met.

8th To see, if the Town will take any Measures, to Hire some suitable person, or persons, for Collector, or Collectors, to Collect the Town Taxes, the year ensuing, - to do or act &c.

9th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for the purpose of defraying the expenses, that has arisen, in consequence of Nahum Tower, being imprisoned in Concord Goal, to do or act, &c.

10th To see, if the Town, will accept the List of Jurors, as presented by the selectmen, - do or act, &c. &c.

11th To see, if the Town, will take any Measures for Opening the New County Road, in the Northw^{ly} part of the Town, Agreeable to the request of M^r. Isaac Puffer, do or act, &c. &c.
