7th Voted, to appoint a school Committee as Express in this Article, said Committee to consist of five Persons ^{to be taken} One out of each School district, & the following Persons were appointed, Vizt - for the centre district Reuben Maynard, S. E. District, Capt Joseph Goodnow, N. W. District Col. J. Rice, S. W. District M. Pease How N. E. District Lt. Caleb Wheeler - also by their Vote, Invested them with the same Powers, that their School Com^{tee} were invested with the Last year, - also Established the Rules Orders, & discipline, which were observed in each particular School, the year Last past, -

9th Voted, that it be left discretionary with the Selectmen, for them to act, Respecting what is mentioned in this Article as they in their Opinion, Judge most for the Interest of the Town, -

10th Accepted the List of Jurors as presented, by the Selectmen, -
