

May Anno Domini, 1804.

These are to Notify, & Warn, the Male Inhabitants of the Town of Sudbury, being twenty One years of age, & resident in said Town, for the space of One year next preceding, having a Freehold Estate within said Town, of the annual Income of three Pounds, or any estate to the Value of Fifty pounds, to Meet, at the Meeting-House in said Town On Monday the 7th day of May Next at 1 o'clock in the afternoon, for the purpose of choosing a Representative to represent them, at the General Court, appointed to be convened, and held at Boston, on the last Wednesday of May Next.

Also all the Freeholders, & Other Inhabitants of said Town, Qualified as the Law directs to vote in Town affairs, to Meet, at the above-Mentioned place & time, to act on the following Articles, Viz^t.

- 1st To Choose a Moderator and act upon the 4th Article in the warning of April Meeting, & refer'd to May Meeting for further Consideration.
- 2^d To see, if the Town will take any Measures, for Opening & Making the Road, which has been Lay'd out by a Courts Committee beginning at How Line & thence Leading through the Northerly part of said Town, to do, or act, as the Town shall think best where Mett.
- 3^d To see, if the Town will give Liberty for such Neat Cattle, to go at large the present year as a Committee who they shall see fit to appoint, for that purpose, shall think proper, to do or act &c &c
- 4th To see, if the Town will, agreeable to the Request of Mr. Miah Balcom, take any Measures to prevent Horses going at Large, with fetters, the present year, Do, or act, &c &c
- 5th To see, if the Town will Give any encouragement to such persons, as shall take Measures for destroying of crows in said Town, Do or act &c &c
- 6th To see if the Town will take any Measures, for Repairing & painting the Meeting-House in said Town, Do - or act, &c &c
