The above Notification, has been posted up at the desire of the Selectmen, & agreeable to a former vote of the Town,

Warrington accepted, Dr. Reuben Maynard, Clerk.

At a Legal Town Meeting held in Sudbury, on Monday the 8th Day of October, 1804. Proceeded to the business of the day, as follows. Viz^t

1st Article made choice of M^r. William Hunt, for their Moderator

2^d Granted the sum of \$246⁰⁰ 66⁰⁰ 7 as a Salary, to the Rev^d. M^r. Bigelow, for the year ensuing.

Also granted, as a Gratuity to their Rev^d. Ministers, the sum of \$86⁰⁰ 66⁰⁰ 7. Provided he supplies the Pulpit, the year ensuing.

3rd Article, Paid Over for the present.

5th Granted the sum of \$500, for the relief of the Poor the Present year.

6th Granted, to pay their Treas^r. the sum of \$10⁰⁰ 00 00 To pay their Assessors the sum of \$15⁰⁰ 00 00

7th The Town, by their Vote, directed the Selectmen, to agree with, & hire some suitable person, to perform the business express in this Article.

8th Article, Paid Over for the present.

9th directed the Selectmen, to make such repairs immediately, to the deck of the Meeting-House, as to them appear expedient, - and to report to the Town, at the adjournment of this Meeting, what further repairs are necessary to be made, and the probable expense of said repairs.

10th appointed a Committee of five persons, One to be taken out of each School district, for the purpose
