to consist of five Persons, One to be taken out of each School district
said Committee to be appointed by ballot, & the following Persons
were elected, Vizt, Col. Jon^s Rice, Lt. Caleb Wheeler, Major Jonas Hol-
den, Mr. Adam How, & Reuben Maynard, — then the Town at
Col. Rice's Request excus'd him from serving on said Comtee
and Lt. Joseph Willis was chosen in his stead, — also by
their vote, Invested them with the same powers, that their
School Committee were Invested with the year past — also
established the same Rules, Orders, & discipline, which were to be
Observed, in each particular School the year past, in —
9th Article, Voted to adjourn this Meeting, to this Day week at 4 o'clock
in the afternoon, to meet at this Place — also by their vote, di-
-rected their agents appointed for the purpose of carrying into
effect, the action instituted by said Town, against Peter Smith
to make out the whole amount of the expence in supporting
said action, together with damages allow'd by the court and re-
-port to the Town, at the adjournment, of this Meeting.

Sudbury Monday March 19th 1805.

The Town being well agreeable to the foregoing adjournment
Proceeded to the business of said day and took up the —
11th Article, and the Question was put to see, if the Town would
-make their annual Town Grants, in the Month of May, in-
-stead of the Month of October, the present year, which being
put to vote, it pass'd in the affirmative.

12th The Town, by their Vote, appointed a Committee of three per-
-sons, for the purpose of carrying into effect, the grant
made in October last, for repairing and painting the Meet-
-ing-House in said Town, & Col. Jon^s Rice, Lt. Dan^l
N. Smith & Mr. Sam^l Jones were appointed, for the
above purpose.

9th Then voted to take up this article again, & after a considera-
-ble debate had upon the subject matter of this Article, it
was voted to pass over said article for the present.
