Exclusive of the Towns demands, in supporting the cause between Said Town, & the Town of Concord & John Richardson, respecting this according Said Smith, as will more fully appear, by the account as exhibited by said agents, reference thereto being had; also by their vote, directed their agents to discharge the aforesaid execution on in full against Said Rice, upon his giving security on interest to the Town Treas^r. for the sum of \$ 5/5⁰⁰ 94⁰⁰ (including the bill of cost to Esq^r. Ward), it being the balance due Said Town on said execution, said security to be given in behalf of the Town & to the acceptance of the Treas^r.

15th The Question was put to see, if the Town would suffer that Cattle, to go at Large the present year & it pass^d in the Negative.

10th Article, Voted, to let out the collecting of the Taxes, which shall be assessed upon the Inhabitants of Said Town, for the year ensuing, to such person, or persons as will take it at the lowest per cent, said collector or collectors, to have the privilege of being Constable for Said Town, also said Collector, or Constable, to procure good & sufficient bondsmen, to the acceptance of the Selectmen, & Town Treas^r. for the payment of the Money they shall have authority to collect into the Town Treas^r. — and M^r. Abel Moore being the lowest bidder, undertook to collect the whole of the Taxes which shall be assessed upon said Town for the year ensuing, for the privilege of being Constable for said Town, for the year ensuing.

Then the Town by their vote, made choice of M^r. Abel Moore for their Constable, for the year ensuing, who was sworn to the faithful discharge, of his duty by the Clerk of said Town.

It was then Moved & Seconded, that the Choice of Hog Revers might be reconsidered, which being put to vote, it pass^d in the Negative.
